


General Assembly Guidelines


- 1. Read the instructions carefully before beginning the assembly process to ensure proper assembly of this product. Please open and inspect the contents of box(es) to see that all parts and hardware are included.






3. Understanding How the Cam Fastener Works







Screw cam bolts flush as illustrated.

surface. The arrow direction must be in the direction of the hole.

Press cam into hole until flush with Insert bolt through pre-drilled Turn clockwise to lock cam with bolt. hole in edge of panel.

Tip: place a small bit of WD-40 or similar lubricant into the pre-installed cam bolt holes to help the cam bolts screw in better./



4. Glue provided is to secure wood dowels in place and is optional. If glue is used during assembly, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately. It is not necessary to glue the other end of the dowel when attaching to other parts.




Use and Care Your cabinet normally requires a minimum amount of maintenance; however, the following points are worth noting:

Cleaning - To remove marks and enhance the surface, wipe with a gentle all-purpose cleanser. DO NOT use ammonia-based, harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning agents. Wipe dry immediately.

Electrical and Hydraulic Lifts - Require annual lubrication with WD-40 or similar lubricant.













Insert c1 Cam Bolts on Panels X and Z into cams on Panel D. Tighten cams and apply c2 Cam Covers.



LIFT INSTALLATION WARNING:


DO NOT remove the small wooden block from the Lift until assembly is complete. If the block is removed or falls out before lift assembly is complete, the cables will retract, making installation more difficult. If the block falls out before complete assembly, please visit www.arrowsewing.com/assembly and find the "Alternate Sewing Lift Installation" video.

This illustration shows the back view of the **Lift**. Notice the wooden block, red ribbon, and zip ties; the wooden block holds the piston in place so that the cables can be easily handled and inserted into the **Lift Rails** installed on your cabinet.

Do not pull on the red ribbon or remove the zip ties just yet!



Part 2: Lift Panel

Guide Lift onto Lift Rails using plastic guides. Insert ends of cable into rail tabs; make sure the cable is hooked into the rail tabs on both sides.


Cut the zip ties on the lift, but DO NOT remove the block yet.


First lower the **Lift** to first lock position. **DO NOT ADJUST THE LIFT AGAIN UNTIL THE TOP OF THE CABINET IS INSTALLED.** Moving the lift back up before the top is installed will dislodge the cables from the rail tabs and uninstall your lift.



Once your cabinet is completely assembled, make sure that the zip ties and wooden block are removed. If the wooden block does not fall out on its own after the zip tie holding it is cut, pull on the red ribbons to dislodge it.





Lower **Panel A**, inserting cam bolts on **Panel A** onto cams on **Panels X**, **D**, **Y** and **Z**. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.




Attach h2 Butt Hinges to Panels 01 and 02 using s1 Screws.

Attach **m Magnet Catch Plates** to underside of **Panels 01 and 02** using **s2 Screws**.

Screw s4 Alignment Pins into the pre-drilled hole in the top of Panels O1 and O2.


Screw t1 Casters into the bottom of Panels 01 and 02. Tighten with r3 Wrench.





Attach h2 Butt Hinges to Panels 03 and 04 using s1 Screws.

Attach m Magnet Catch Plates to the underside of Panels O3 and O4 using s2 Screws.

Screw s4 Alignment Pins into the pre-drilled hole in the top of Panels 03 and 04.








Extend Gate Leg **Panels 01 and 02.** Balance **Panel A1** on gate legs and attach **h1 Hinges** to Panel A (top) using **s1 Screws.**

Extend Support **Panels O3 and O4.** Balance **Panel A5** on support panels and attach **h1 Hinges** to Panel A (top) using **s1 Screws.**






Slide Panel L4 into grooves on Panels L, L1 and L2.

Connect Panel L3 to Panels L1 and L2 using s3 Screws.




Using **s1 Screws**, attach **m Magnet** to **Panel A3** as illustrated.

Slide **Panel A3** into place, inserting threaded dowel pins into predrilled holes and clicking magnet into place.

WHAT THIS WARRANTY COVERS: Arrow Companies, LLC "Arrow" provides a Limited Lifetime Warranty "Warranty" to the original purchaser of this product against defects in materials or workmanship of furniture components. As used in this Warranty, "defect" means imperfections in components which substantially impair the utility of the product. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state. Electrical and mechanical components of furniture are warrantied for 5 years.

HOW TO GET SERVICE: Simply contact Arrow at 1-800-533-7347 or CS@ArrowSewing.com. When you request Warranty service, you must also present proof of purchase documentation, which includes the date of purchase (detailed receipt), and photos of the product. Arrow will replace any defective part (at its sole option), excluding labor. Replacement parts will be warranted for only the remaining period of the original Warranty.

Replacement parts will be shipped freight prepaid on any initial Warranty claim during first year of Warranty only. Warranty applies only to defects confirmed by Arrow and will be replaced or repaired at Arrow's option. In the event parts are no longer available for a Warranty claim, customer may receive a brand new cabinet at a price equal to 60% off the MSRP of a current comparable model.

WHAT'S NOT COVERED: There is no Warranty coverage for defects or conditions that result from the failure to follow product assembly instructions, information or warnings, misuse or abuse, intentional damage, fire, flood, alteration or modification of the product, or use of the product in a manner inconsistent with its intended use, nor any condition resulting from incorrect or inadequate maintenance, cleaning, care, or neglect, cuts or scratches, caster damage as a result of moving furniture fully loaded or with locked casters, damage resulting from electrical surge or lightning, or use in commercial or education environments. Kangaroo Sewing Furniture is designed for residential use only.


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
