General Assembly Guidelines

1. Read the instructions carefully before beginning the assembly process to ensure proper assembly of this product. Please open and inspect the contents of box(es) to see that all parts and hardware are included.

2. Tools Required



Phillips Screwdriver ⊕

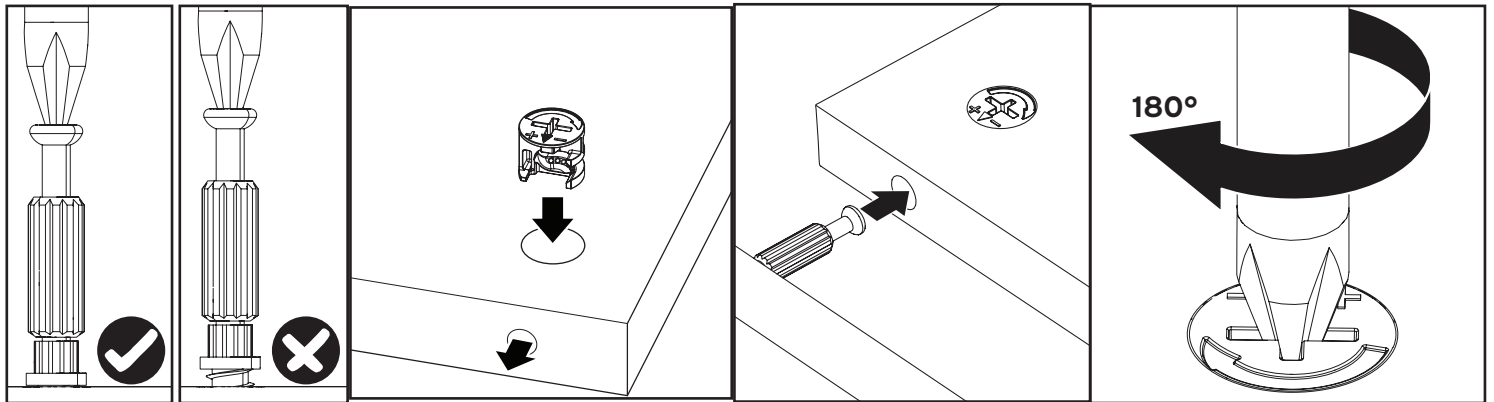

Torque set to 3-5

3. Understanding How the Cam Fastener Works



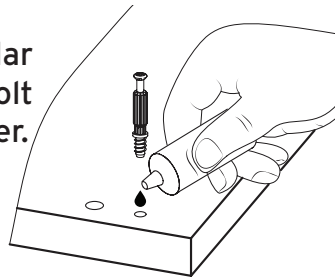
Screw cam bolts flush as illustrated.

Press cam into hole until flush with surface. The arrow direction must be in the direction of the hole.

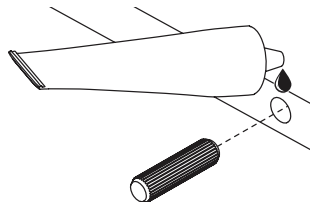
Insert bolt through pre-drilled hole in edge of panel.

Turn clockwise to lock cam with bolt.

Tip: place a small bit of WD-40 or similar lubricant into the pre-installed cam bolt holes to help the cam bolts screw in better.



4. **Glue** provided is to secure wood dowels in place and is optional. If glue is used during assembly, locate the appropriate hole for the dowel, place a small amount of glue in the hole and insert the dowel. Wipe away excess glue immediately. It is not necessary to glue the other end of the dowel when attaching to other parts.

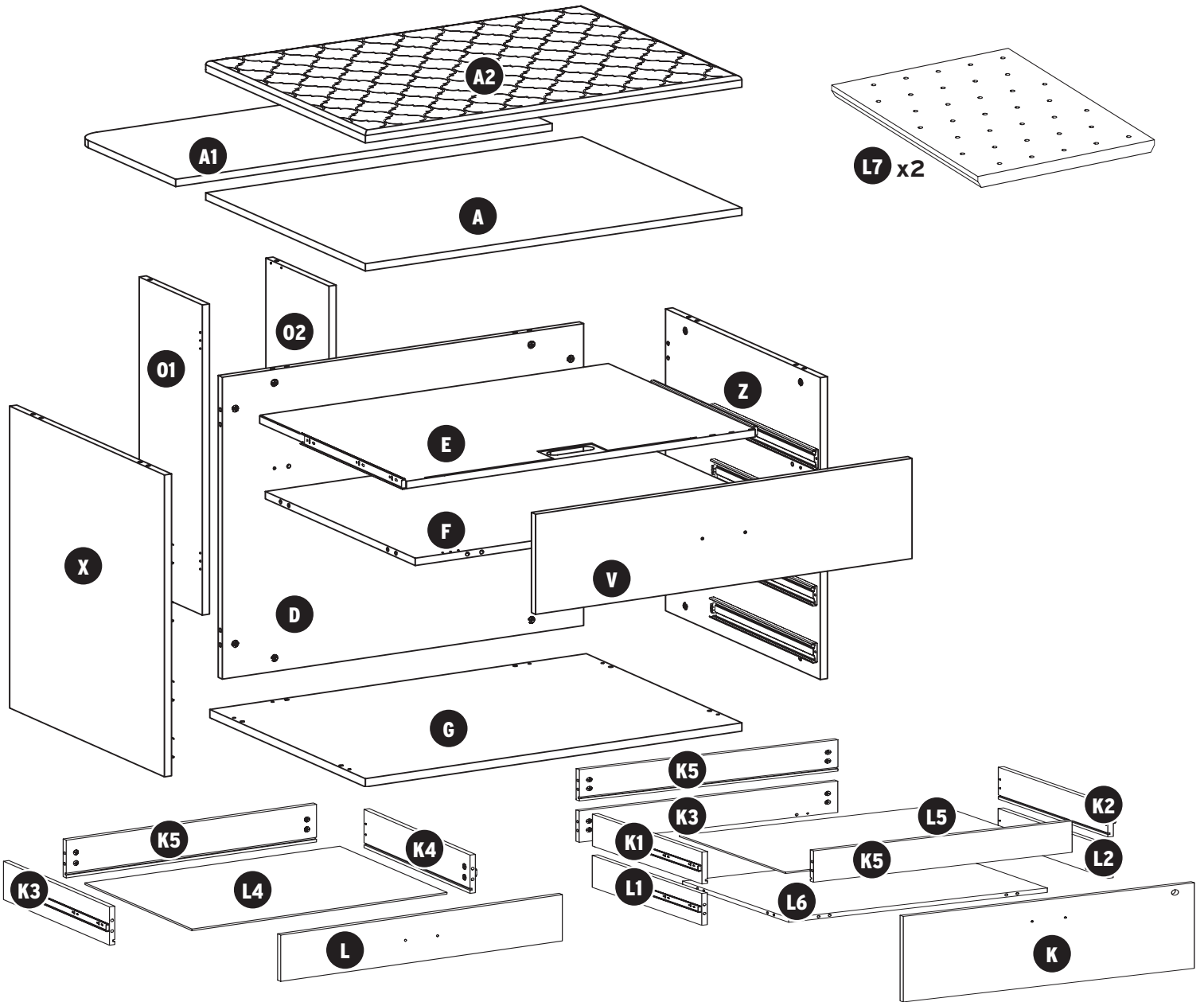


Use and Care Your cabinet normally requires a minimum amount of maintenance; however, the following points are worth noting:

Cleaning - To remove marks and enhance the surface, wipe with a gentle all-purpose cleanser. **DO NOT** use ammonia-based, harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning agents. Wipe dry immediately.

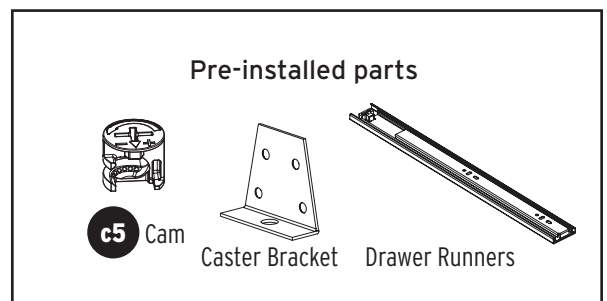
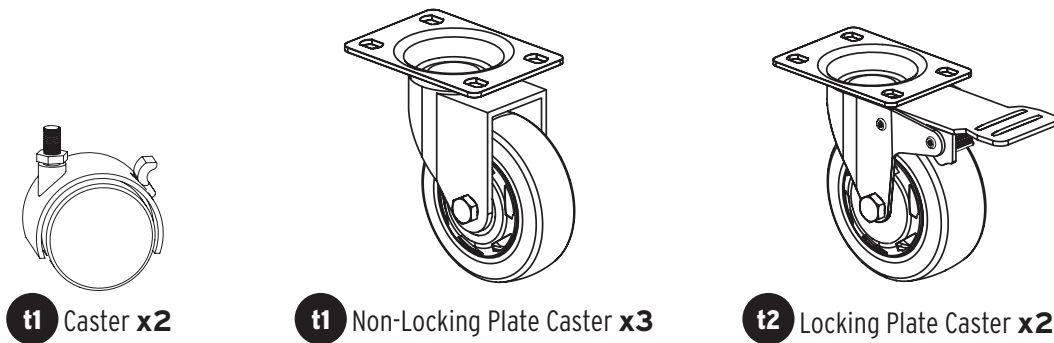
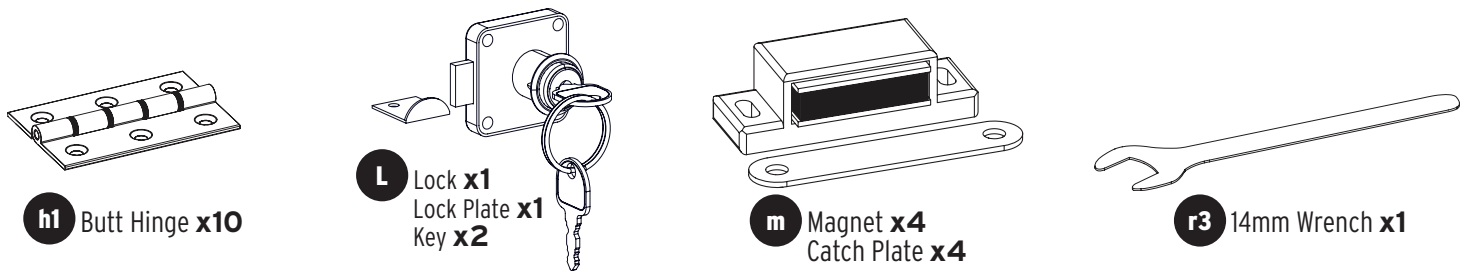
Electrical and Hydraulic Lifts - Require annual lubrication with WD-40 or similar lubricant.

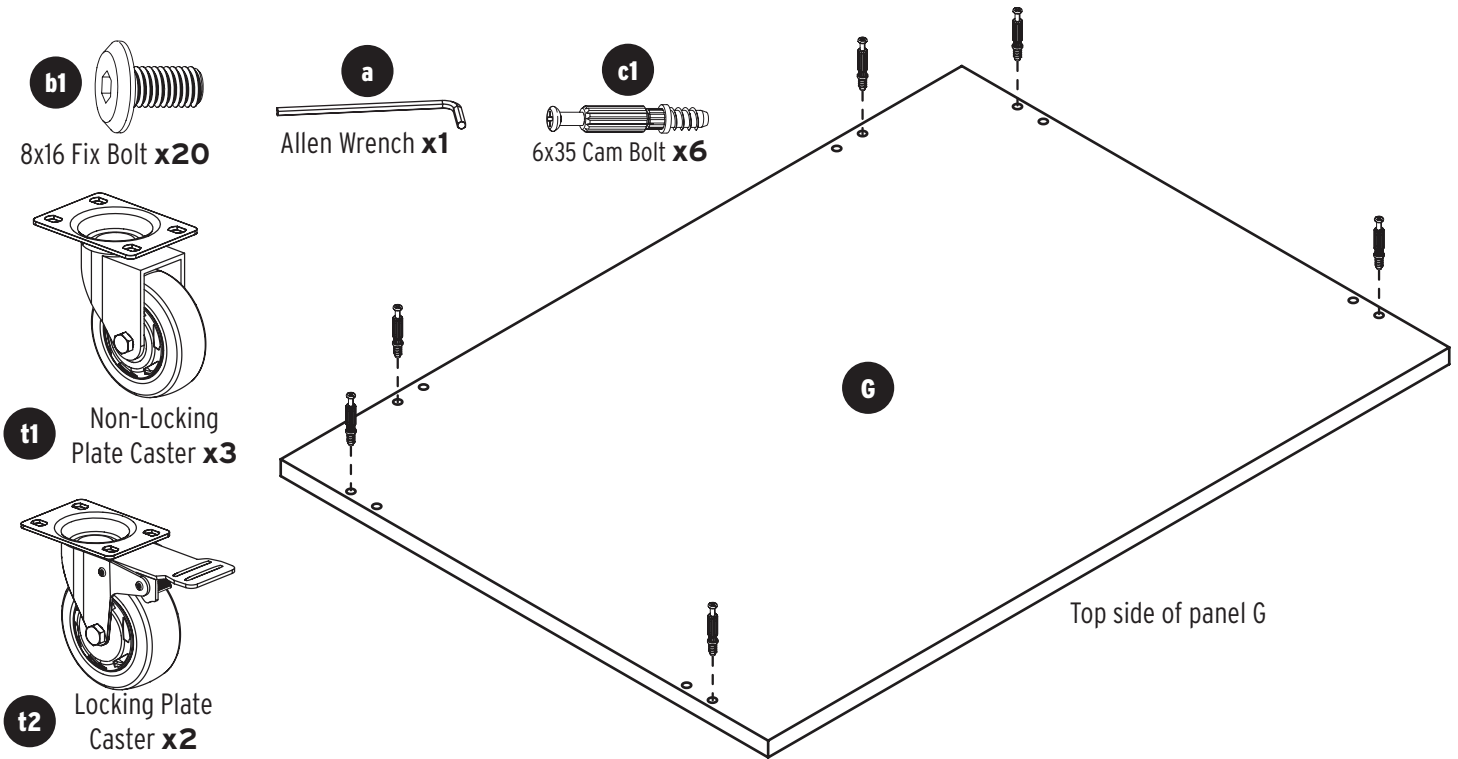

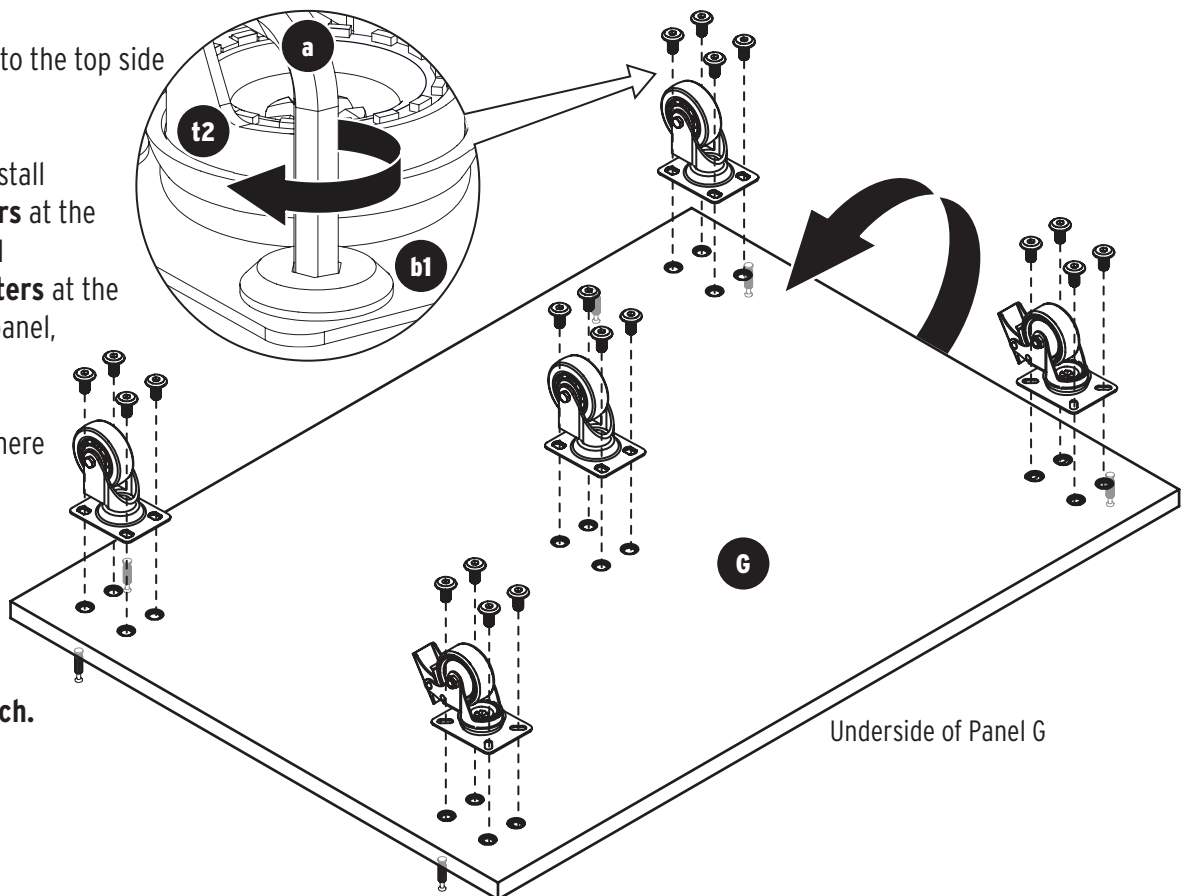
Install 6 **c1 Cam Bolts** into the top side of **Panel G**.

Flip **Panel G** over, and install **t2 Locking Plate Casters** at the front of the panel, and **t1 Non-Locking Plate Casters** at the middle and back of the panel, with **b1 Fix Bolts**.

Pay close attention to where the cam bolts are on the opposite side of the panel for correct caster placement.

Tighten with **Allen Wrench**.

Set **Panel G** aside.

Install **h1 Butt Hinges** using **s1 Screws**.

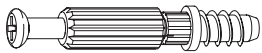
Insert **s5 Alignment Pin** into **Panels 01 and 02**.

Install **t1 Casters** into pre-installed

Tighten with **r3 Wrench**.

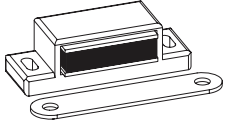
Attach **m Magnet Catch Plate** to the un-
derside of **Panel 02** with **s2 Screws**. Set
aside Magnets for use in the next step.

Locate pilot holes in **Panel A1**. Attach **h1 Butt Hinges** to **Panel A1** with **s1 Screws**.

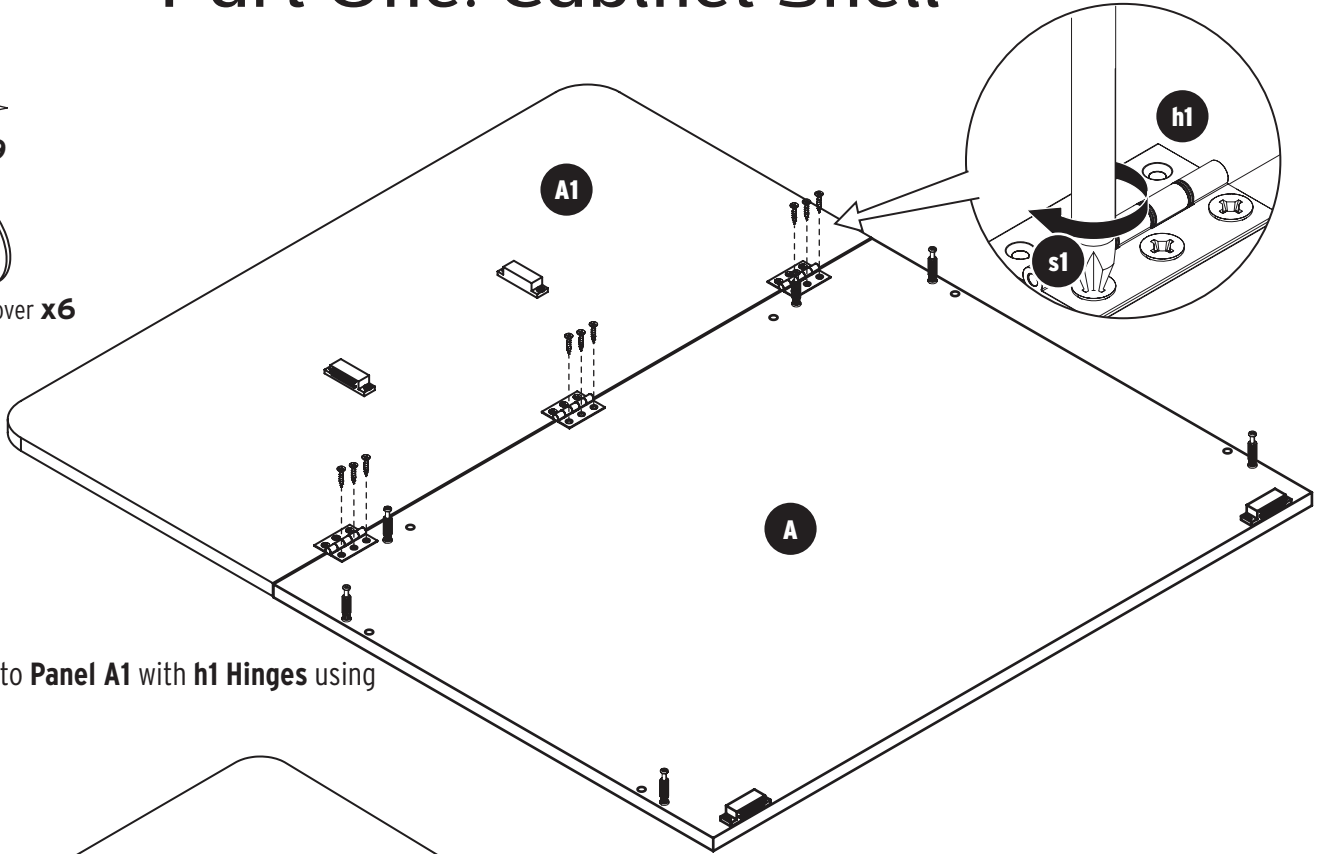

Tighten and apply **Cam Covers**.

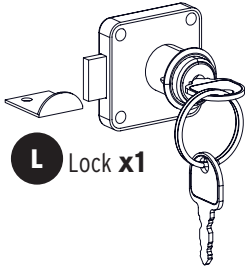

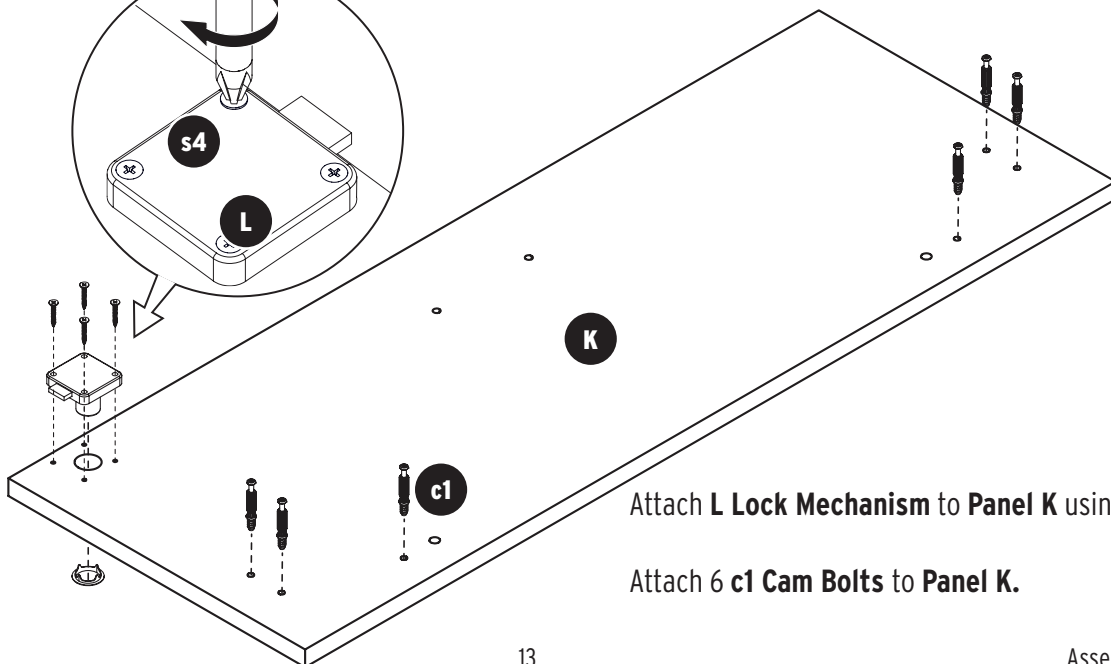
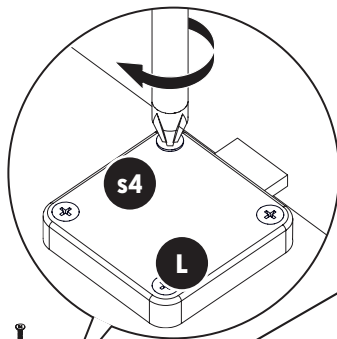
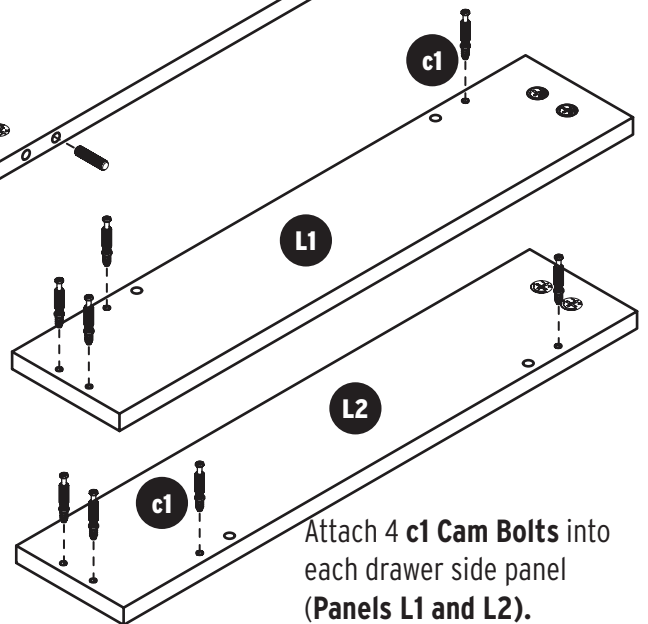
Insert 8 **d1** Dowel Pins into the edges of **Panel L6**

Attach 4 **c1** Cam Bolts into each drawer side panel (**Panels L1 and L2**).



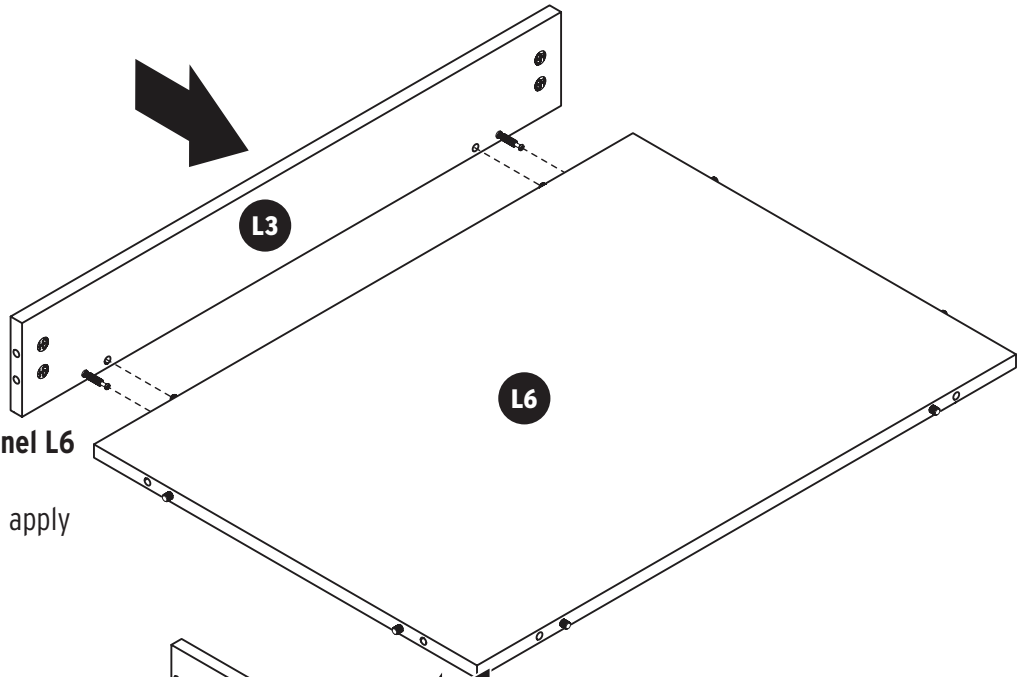
Attach **L** Lock Mechanism to **Panel K** using 4 **s4** screws.

Attach 6 **c1** Cam Bolts to **Panel K**.

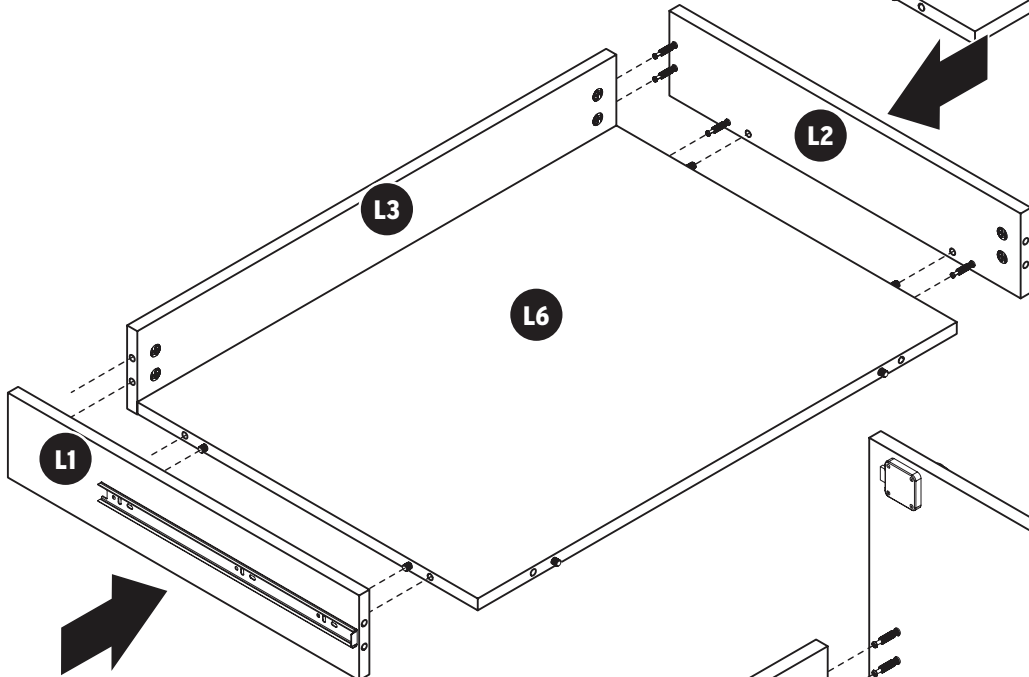

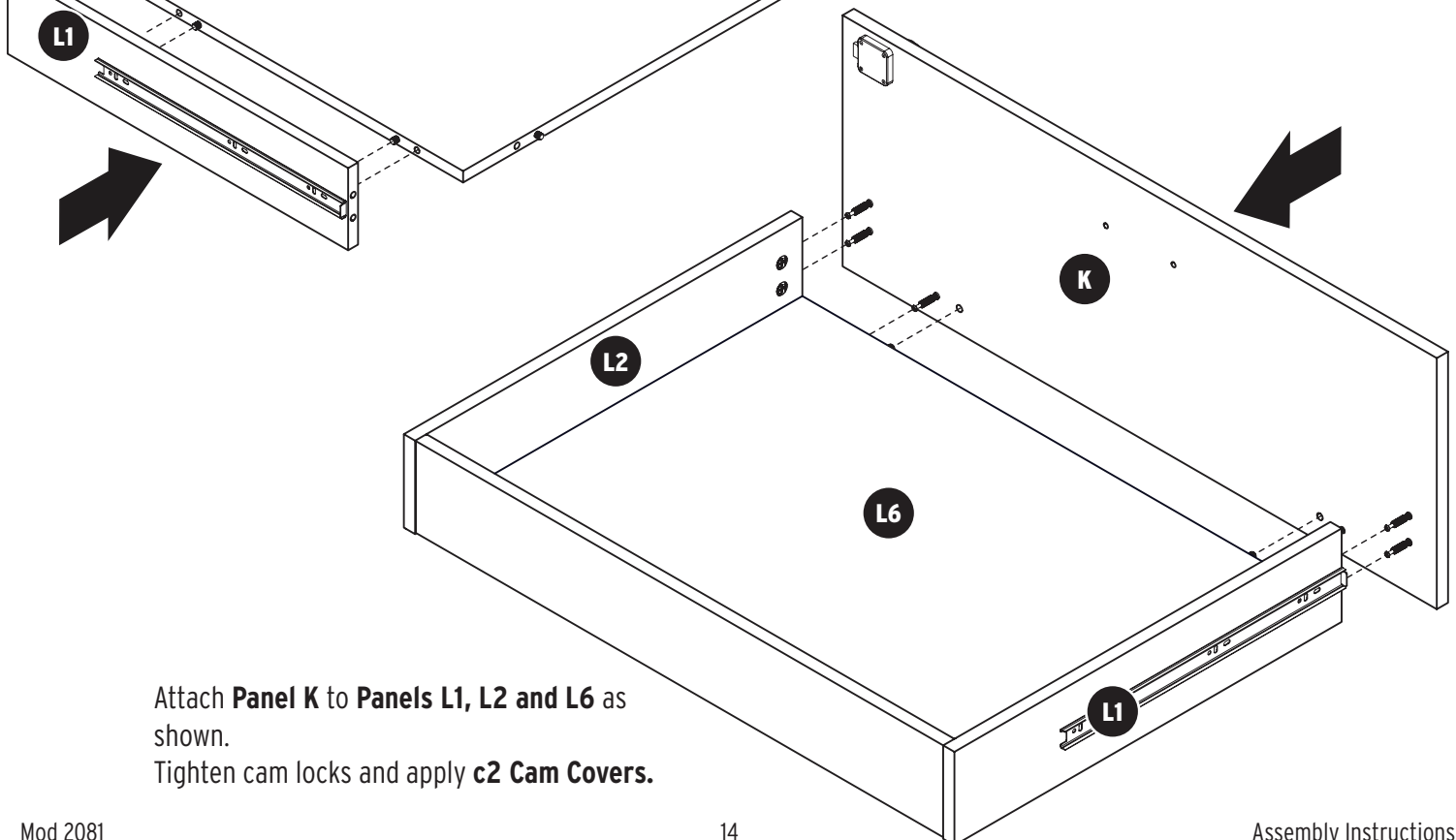
NOTE: Cam Locks on **Panel L6** should be facing down, as illustrated.



Attach **Panel L3** to **Panel L6** as shown.
Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

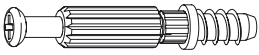


Attach **Panels L1 and L2** to **Panels L3 and L6** as shown.
Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.



Attach **Panel K** to **Panels L1, L2 and L6** as shown.
Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

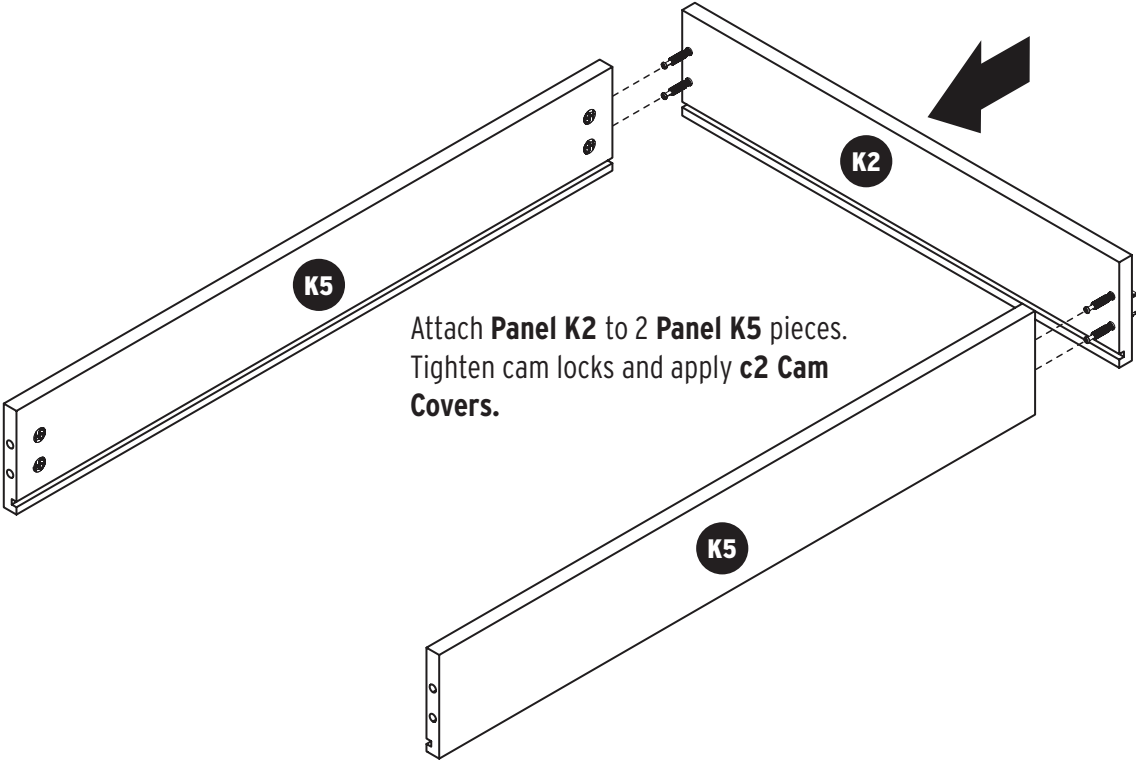
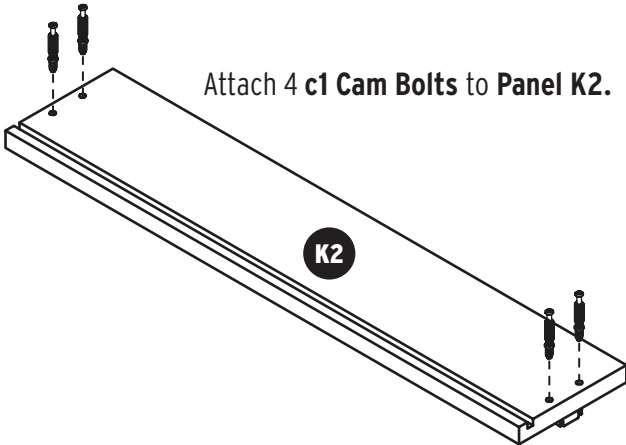
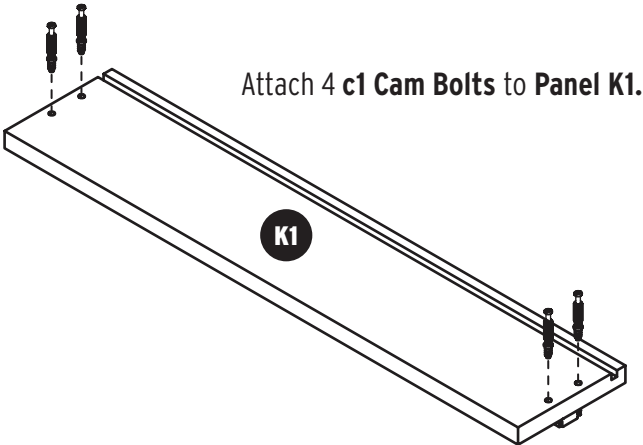

Part Two: Drawers - Middle Drawer

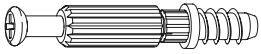


Slide drawer bottom **Panel L5** into the **Panel K2/K5** assembly, being sure to slide the drawer bottom into the grooves on the panels. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.



Attach **Panel K1** to 2 **Panel K5** pieces. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

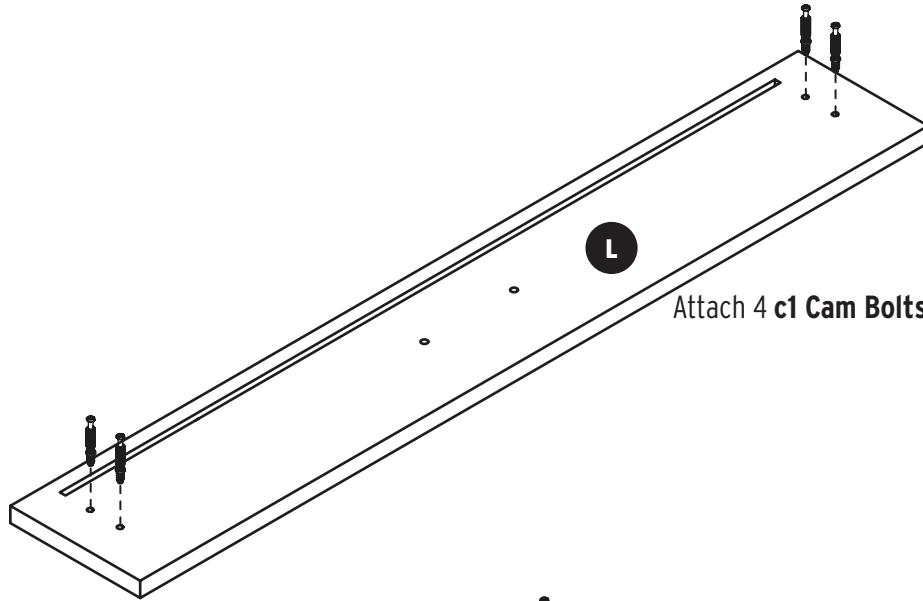

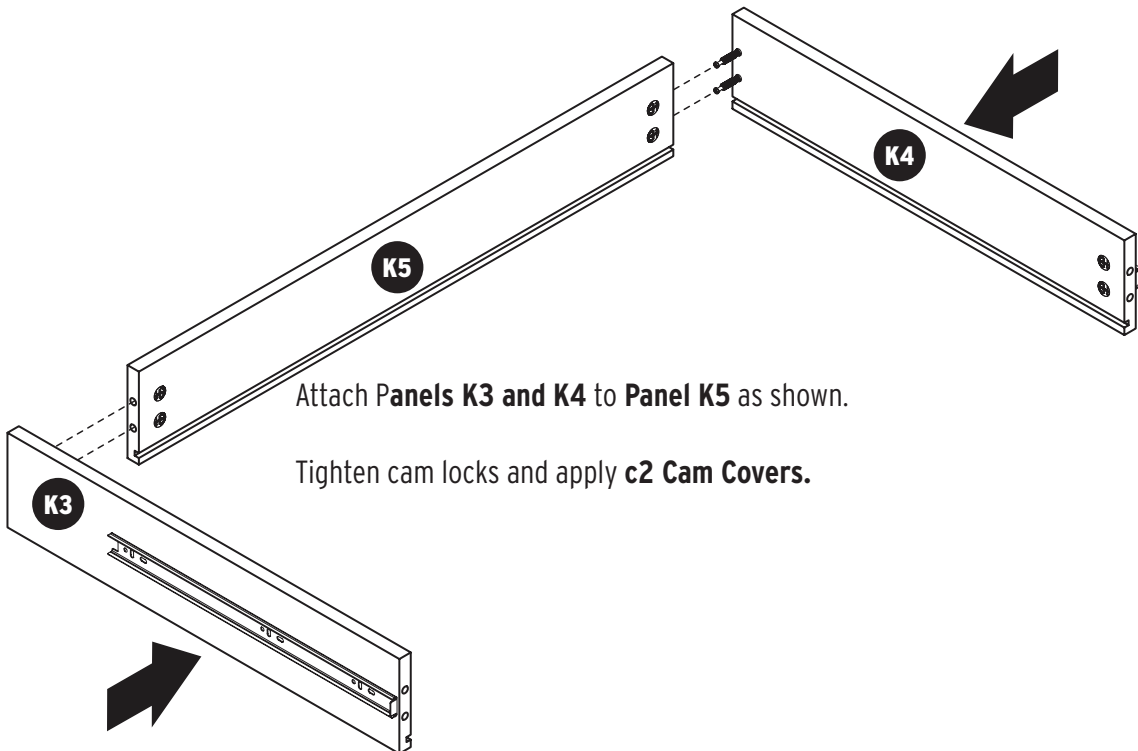
Attach 4 **c1 Cam Bolts** to **Panel L** as shown.

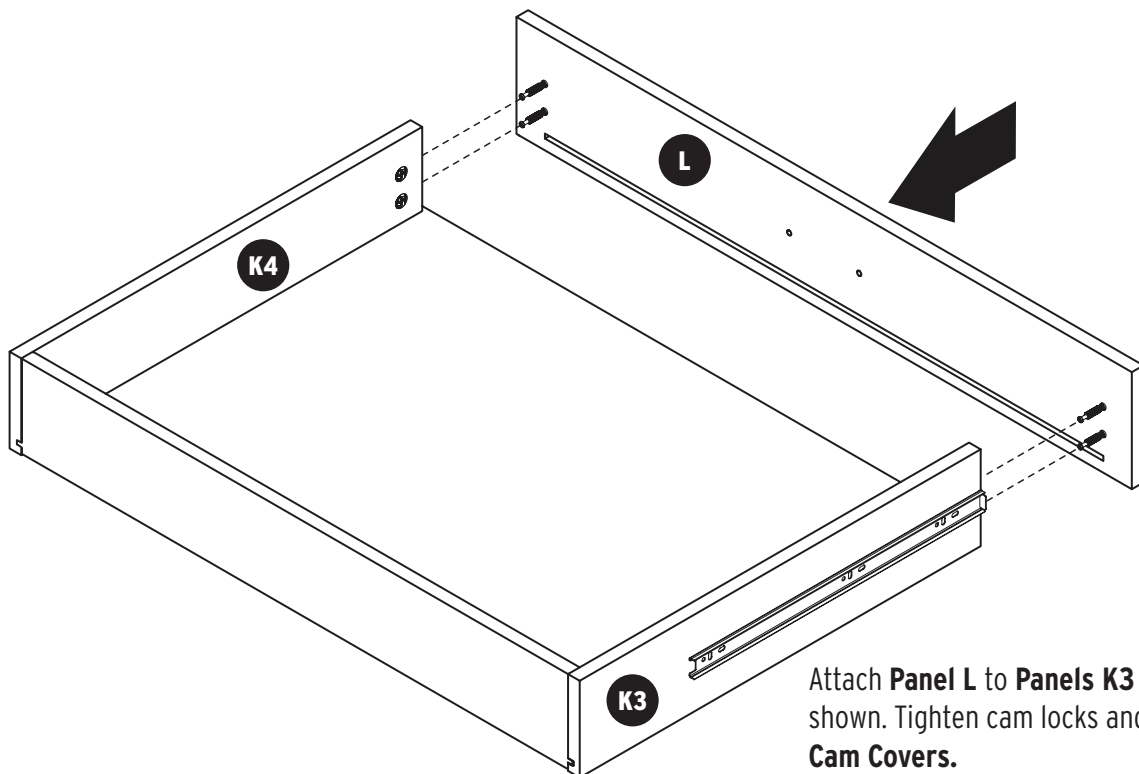
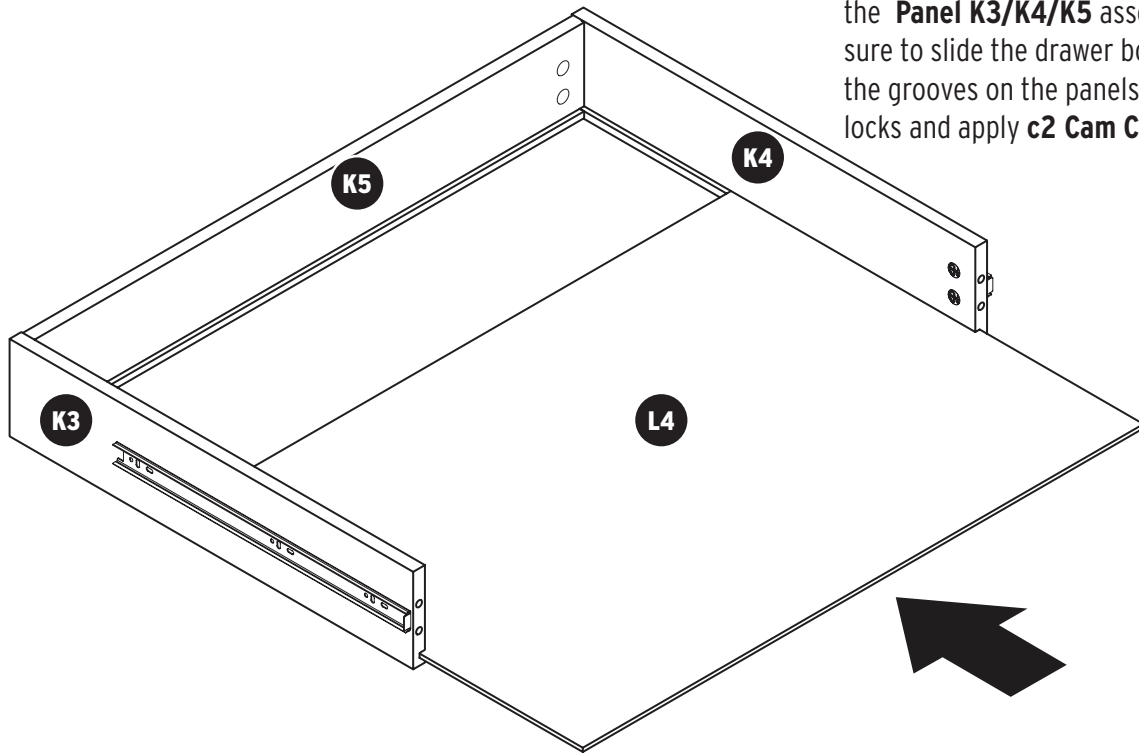
Attach **Panels K3 and K4** to **Panel K5** as shown.

Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

Part Two: Drawers - Top Drawer

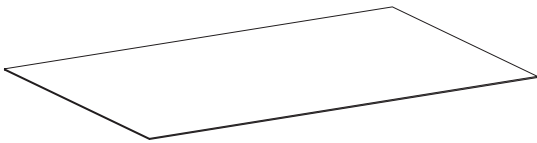

c2 $\frac{5}{8}$ " Cam Cover **x4**

Slide drawer bottom **Panel L4** into the **Panel K3/K4/K5** assembly, being sure to slide the drawer bottom into the grooves on the panels. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

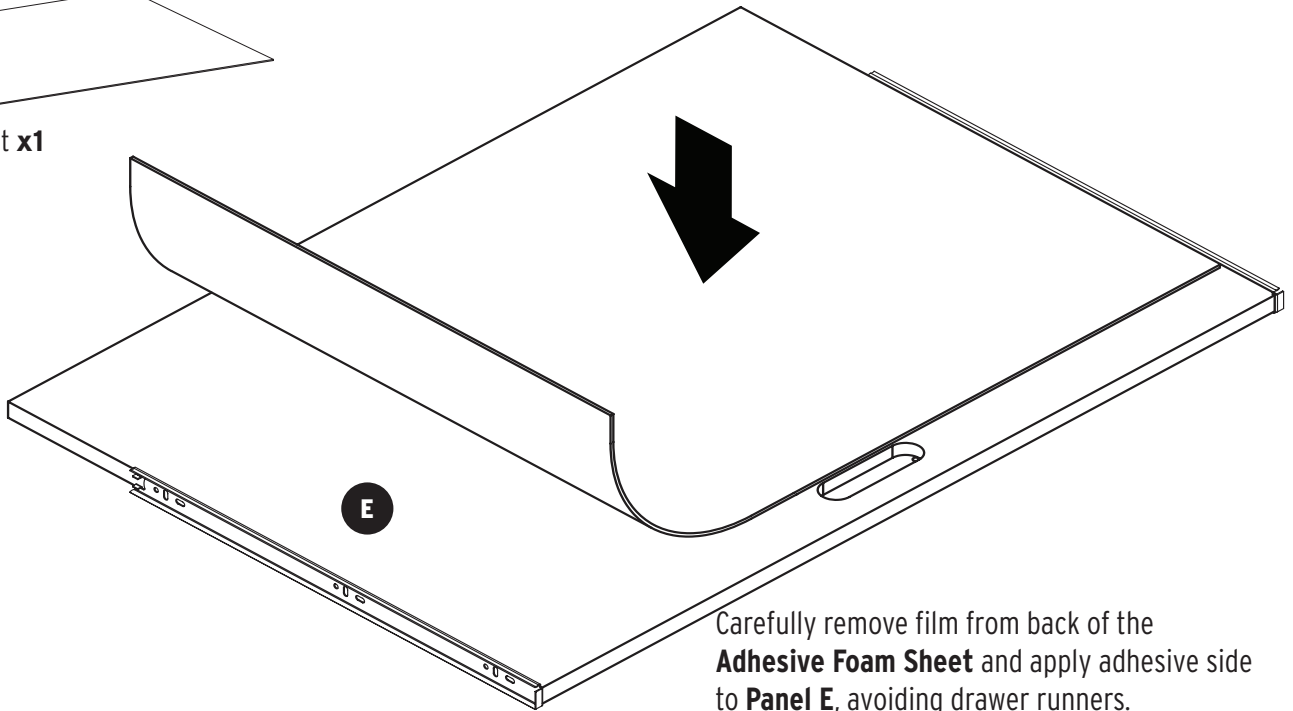


Attach **Panel L** to **Panels K3 and K4** as shown. Tighten cam locks and apply **c2 Cam Covers**.

Part Two: Drawers - Sliding Embroidery Arm Shelf



Adhesive Foam Sheet **x1**



Carefully remove film from back of the **Adhesive Foam Sheet** and apply adhesive side to **Panel E**, avoiding drawer runners.

NOTE: The adhesive is very strong. Be precise when installing!

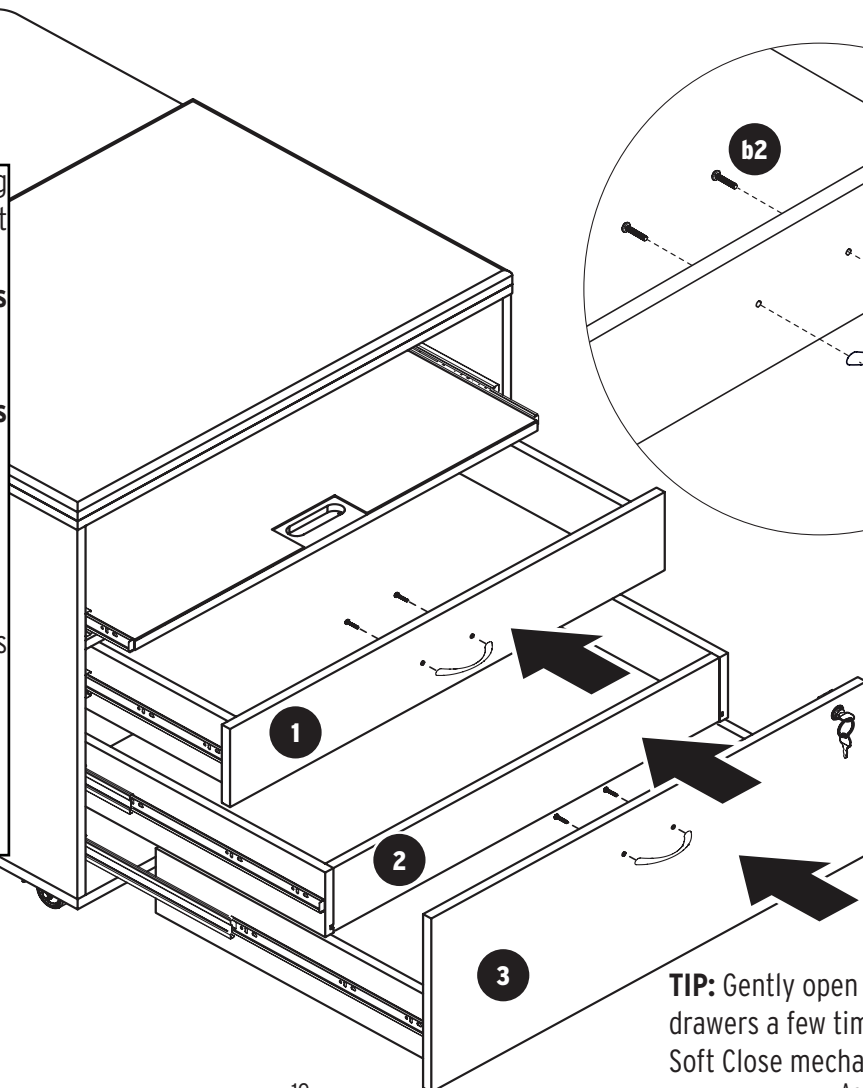
Slide drawers into cabinet, aligning drawer runners. Be sure that cabinet runners are fully extended, with **ball bearing pieces pulled to the front**.

You must install the drawers in this order:

1. Top Drawer
2. Middle Drawer
3. Bottom Drawer

You may need a friend to help with this step, but it is not required.

Once drawers are installed, attach **h Handles** using **b1 Fix Bolts**.

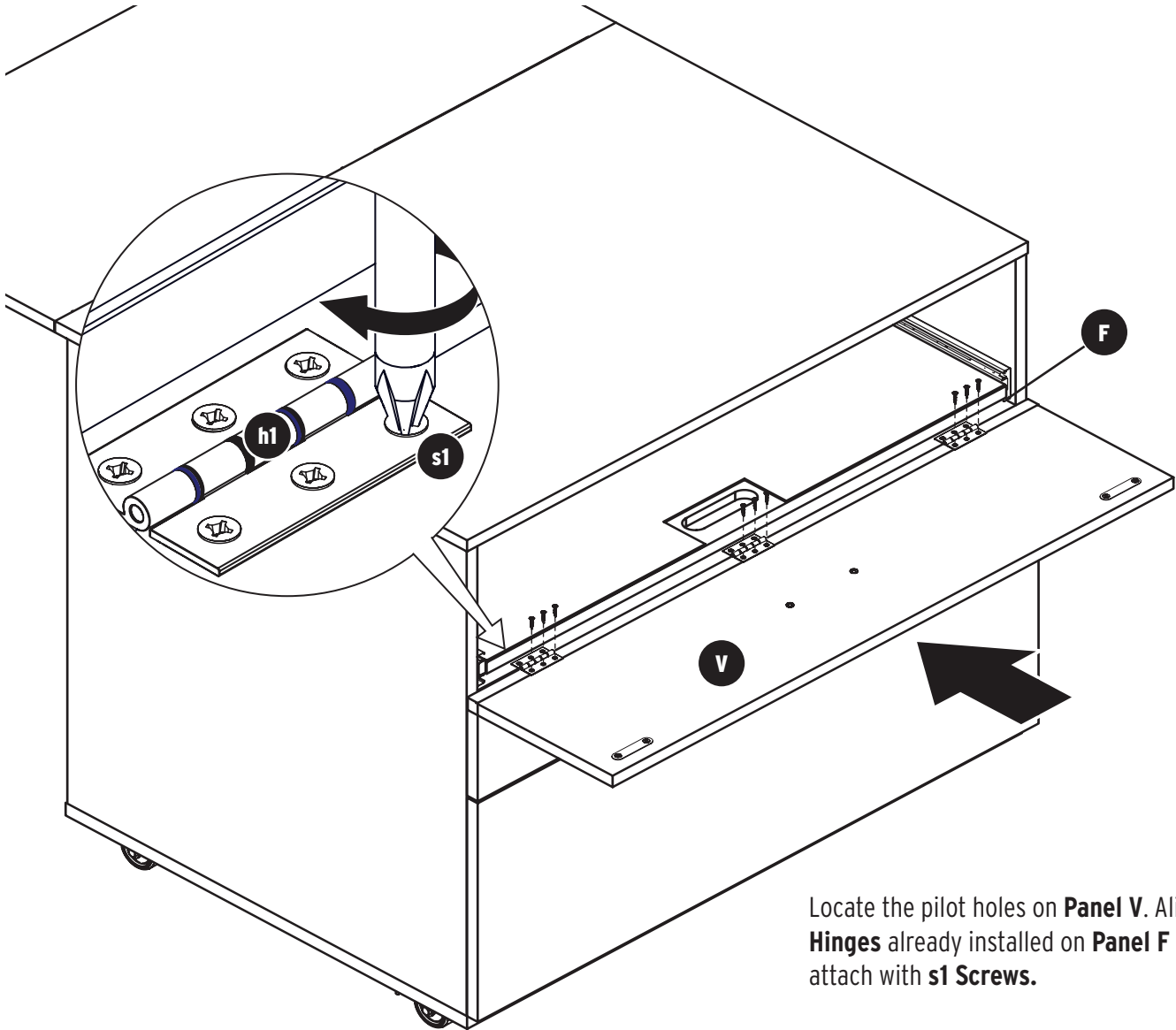


TIP: Gently open and close the drawers a few times to engage the Soft Close mechanism.

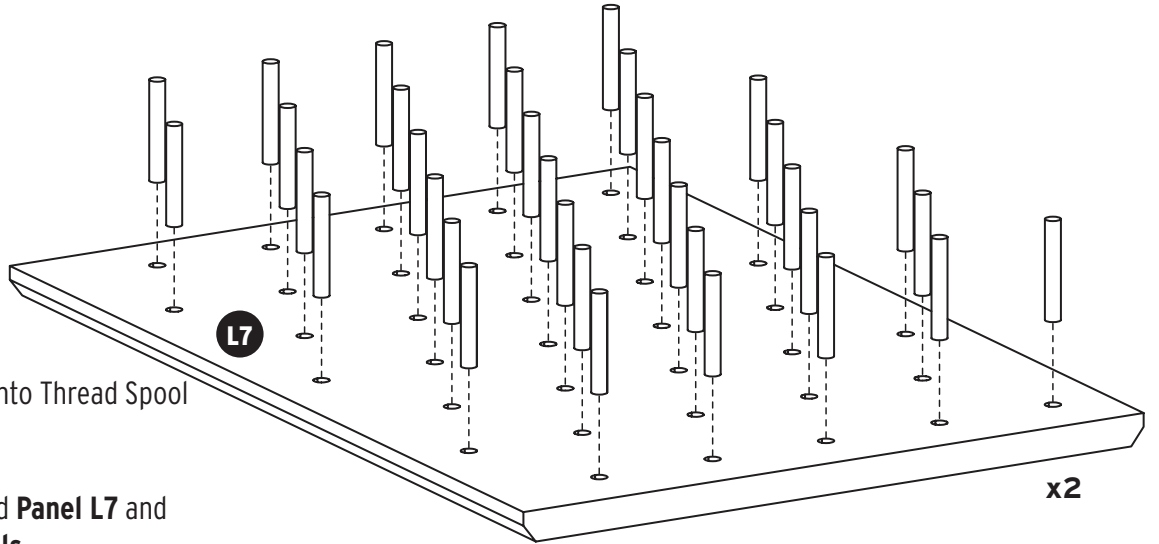


Locate the pilot holes on **Panel V**. Align **Butt Hinges** already installed on **Panel F** and attach with **s1 Screws**.

Part Three: Included Accessories

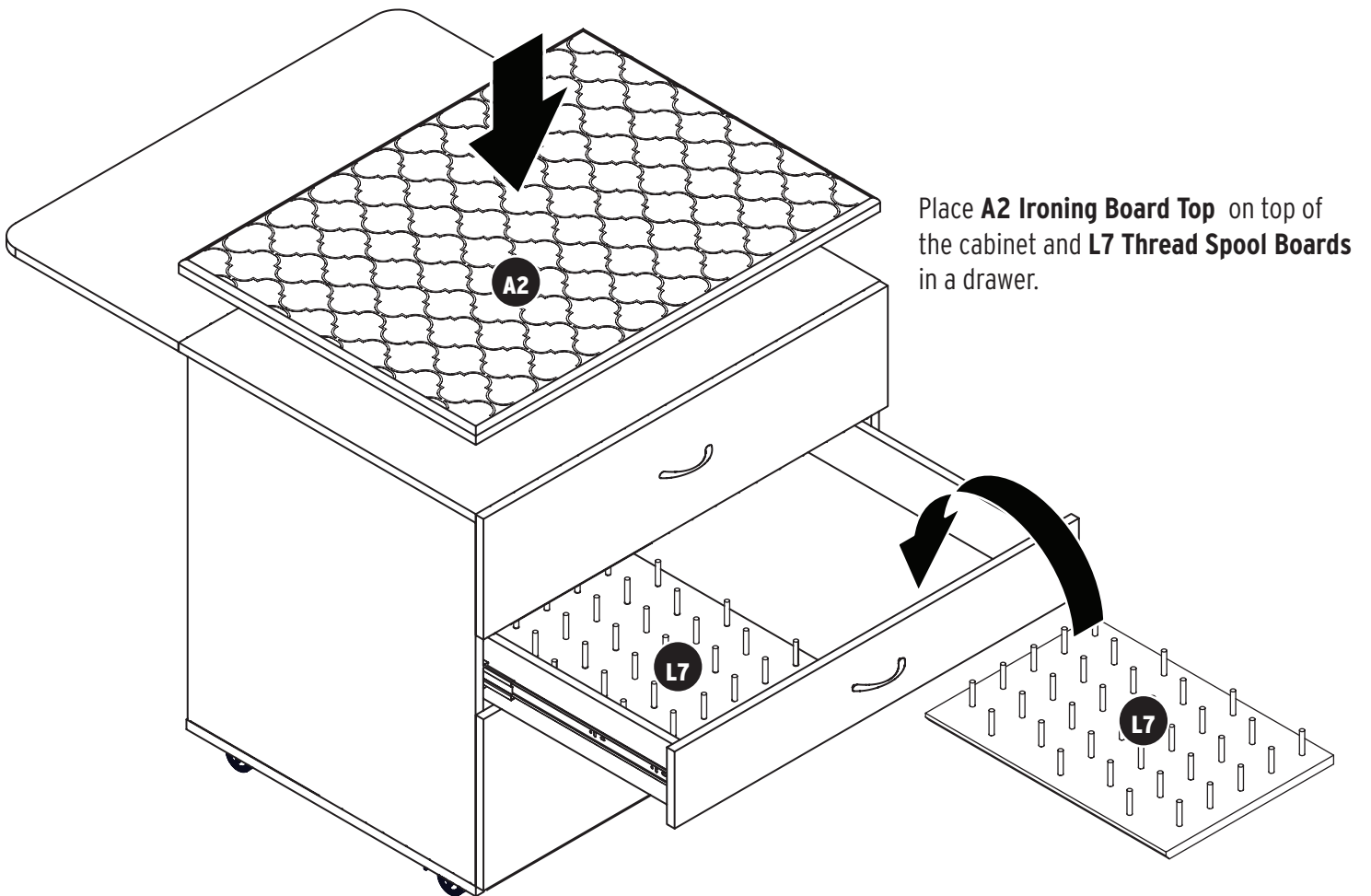


d2 6x50 Dowel Pin **x70**



Insert 35 **d2 Dowels** into Thread Spool Holder **Panel L7**.

Repeat with the second **Panel L7** and remaining 35 **d2 Dowels**.



Place **A2 Ironing Board Top** on top of the cabinet and **L7 Thread Spool Boards** in a drawer.

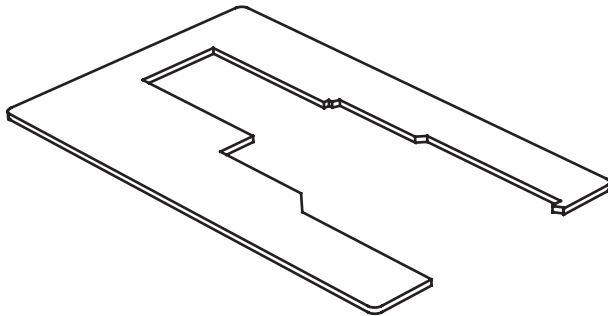

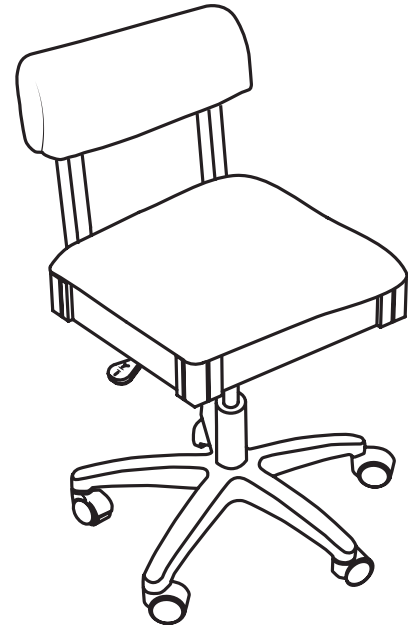
